 - Exhibit location near conference activities
 - Refreshments served within exhibit area
 - Exhibitor directory in the conference agenda book and conference mobile app

The exhibit booth package includes

- One 8' by 10' booth, a 6' draped table, and two chairs
- One discounted participant registration for the conference
- Banquet tickets for dinner in the overflow room
- Up to two name badges giving you access to the exhibitor area

General Exhibitor Information and Rules

- Priority placement will be given to exhibitors who pay for their booth early.
- Authorized representatives of NICWA will be photographing and videotaping at various events throughout the conference. Please be aware that by participating in the conference you will be consenting to the use of your image by NICWA.
- Applications with payments in full are due by February 1, 2020, in order for your contact information to be printed in the conference agenda book. Applications received after this date will be accepted on a space availability basis and may not be included in the conference agenda book.
- Cancellations received in writing prior to February 28, 2020, will receive a refund less a \$100 administrative fee. Refunds will not be issued for cancellations received later than February 28, 2020.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to stay at their booths and not dismantle until the Wednesday, April 1, 2020, at noon. Booths not set up by Monday, March 30, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. may lose their assigned space.
- The contracted agency representative may not lease any portion of the exhibit space to another party.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for purchasing additional items from the convention center, e.g., electrical hookup, internet connection, and any other audiovisual needs.
- The exhibition hall area is in an open area and not under lock and key. Please take appropriate precautions concerning valuables and equipment.
- Arts and crafts vendors must include a payment of at least 50% to reserve a booth and guarantee placement. Forms submitted without the 50% minimum payment have no claim to a booth space or priority space and, in addition, run the risk of having their space sold to another vendor.
- We value arts and crafts vendors celebrating their culture. The Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 (P.L. 101-644) is a truth-in-advertising law that prohibits misrepresentation in marketing of Indian arts and crafts products within the United States. By being an arts and crafts vendor, you must comply with this act.
