One merit-based scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis, up to \$500 to an individual who works in or with the Indian child welfare (ICW) field, and who demonstrates significant motivation in advancing their education or professional skills.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a current NICWA member to apply*
- Must be doing Indian child welfare related work in one the following fields:
 - Social Work
 - Law
 - Policy
 - Research
 - Education
 - Tribal Sovereignty/ Human Rights
 - Behavioral/Mental Health and Wellness

**Must be a current NICWA individual member OR currently employed with a current NICWA tribal/organizational member. (Applicants must show proof of employment with NICWA tribal/organizational members in submitted application materials). Membership status will be verified. Only one (1) scholarship will be awarded per person, per lifetime.*

Applications are due by close of business by Monday, March 16, 2020. Scholarships are announced at our Annual Conference during the Membership Reception held on Sunday, March 29, 2020.
