Upon completion of this training, participants will:

- 1. Conduct a culturally-based interview using ethnographic techniques to build rapport with child welfare families.
- 2. Know the basic elements of a care coordination plan rooted in a culturally-based assessment.
- 3. Recognize and be able to address substance abuse issues in child welfare families.
- 4. Communicate key information to the court via a written court report.
- 5. Know why case recording is essential and what information is standardly kept.
