The selected artist will be awarded a cash prize of \$1,500 for the use of their work in promotional materials for our 2022 conference. Artists also may receive a free arts and crafts vendor spot at our conference as long as they notify NICWA by December 2021. The image will be published on NICWA's website and printed materials reaching thousands, as well as being the visual centerpiece throughout the event. This is a can't-miss opportunity for any Native artist looking to achieve exposure on a national scale.
